School Supplies Swap planned for August, Costume Swap for October, Holiday Decorations Swap in December. Two crates with signs Take A Bag are in place at stores. Dishes Out! lending program have been put on hold during the library issues to be considerate of library workers. Repair Café successful. We plan to increase our advertising by setting out more signs.
- 9. Sustainable Food Security report sent from Levi. Their next meeting July 3 will be looking at plans for the next community garden. Looking forward to seeing the John Phillips Memorial Park Master Plan.
